

# Safe Routes to School Plan

## Executive Summary

In 2017, the Proctor community completed its Safe Routes to School Plan. Safe Routes to School (SRTS) is an international program aimed to improve the safety, health, and well-being of children by enabling and encouraging students to walk and bicycle to school. A SRTS Plan aims to identify strategies to further this cause.

Selected goals identified in the Proctor Schools Safe Routes to School Plan are included below.

## Vision Statement

By 2022, the Proctor Schools SRTS Team envisions an environment in Proctor Public Schools where walking and biking are embedded into curriculum, viewed as "cool" and enjoyable, and prioritized for the sake of student wellness and safety...

### Education



By June 2018, restore ISD 704's bike fleet and acquire additional supplies to aid walking and biking safety education.

### Encouragement



Provide facilities that accommodate and encourage students to ride their bikes to school by September 2019.

### Enforcement



By January 2018, revise the City of Proctor's code of ordinances to address the needs of pedestrians and bicyclists of all ages.

### Engineering



Build accessible trails for students to access Bay View Elementary School through Bay View School Forest by September 2020.

### Engineering



Install traffic controls and signage to create a more effective and efficient student drop-off and pick-up area at each school site by 2022.

### Evaluation



Convene a committee to coordinate efforts at making the Proctor community a better place for walking, biking, and being more active daily.
