MINUTES OF THE PROCTOR CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING WORKING SESSION 2021 BUDGET for Tuesday, November 17, 2020

Meeting called to order at 5:00 PM by Mayor Chad Ward.

BUDGET PRESENTATION: Finance Director Leslie Brunfelt presented a second draft of the proposed 2021 Budget with a preliminary levy increase of 5.75%.

Discussion was held on the feasibility of reducing the levy increase while obtaining a cash reserve goal of 35%-50% (current reserve is 33%.)

Discussion was held on adjusting the budget to reflect a 3% levy increase. Finance Director Brunfelt will make the following adjustments and present the new proposed budget at the December 7, 2020 Truth in Taxation Meeting.

- Reduce PEDA Budget from \$75,000 to \$25,000
- Reduce health insurance costs by \$25,000
- Re-evaluate the legal budget
